

# WildRanger Days

A Wild holiday programme for kids!

## The WildRanger Concept:

WildRanger Days are two or three hour sessions providing 5 to 12 year old children with an unique opportunity to see and learn more about the fantastic native wildlife that surrounds them. The sessions can be integrated with existing children's activity programmes such as vacation care, bushland awareness or environmental education.

### Key features:

- A hands-on presentation of live Australian animals focused on local indigenous species such as pythons, possums, lizards, frogs and birds!
- A nature walk through local bushland (where possible) highlighting our precious natural biodiversity and the importance of nature conservation!
- Craft activities designed to stimulate the creative appreciation of our wonderful wildlife!

### Learning Objectives:

All components of the programme are designed to enhance each child's knowledge and appreciation of Australia's wonderful wildlife and the great Australian bush.

The sessions aim specifically to develop each child's:

- Awareness of Australia's incredible natural biodiversity
- Understanding of the characteristics of certain popular animal species including possums, bats and pythons
- Understanding of the importance of bushland conservation

### Session Content & Costs:

Sessions are designed for approximately 30 children and content can be customised. The core components of the programme are as follows:

#### Two hour option:

- One hour animal presentation
- 20 minute bushwalk
- 10 minute photo session
- 30 minute craft session

**Cost: \$25 per head**

#### Three hour option:

- One hour animal presentation
- 50 minute bushwalk
- 10 minute mini break
- 10 minute photo session
- 50 minute craft session

**Cost: \$35 per head**
